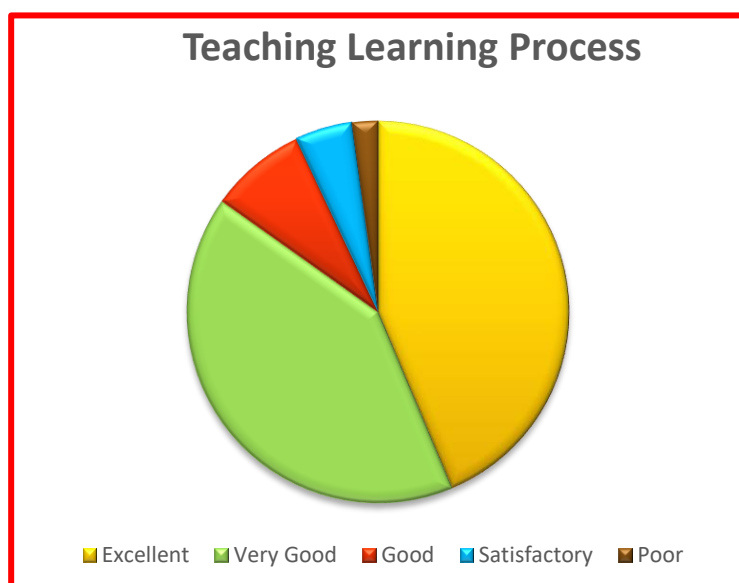
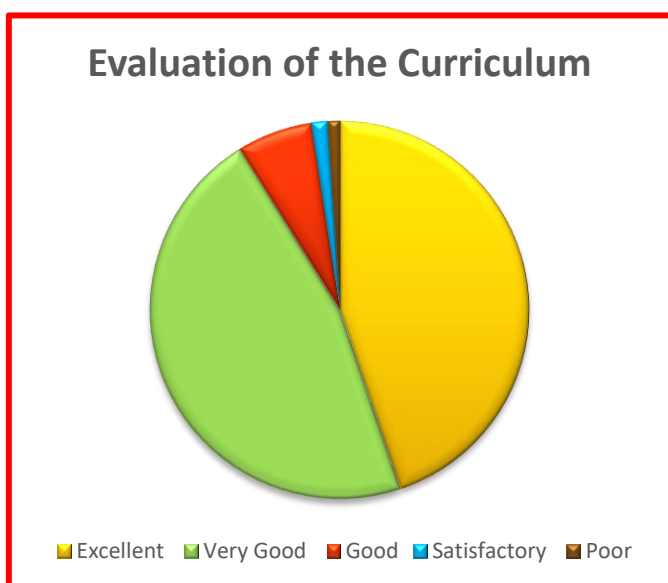

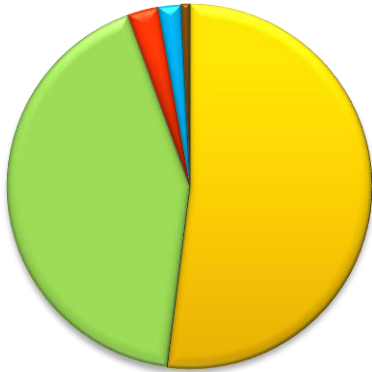

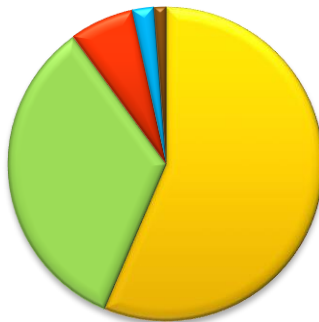

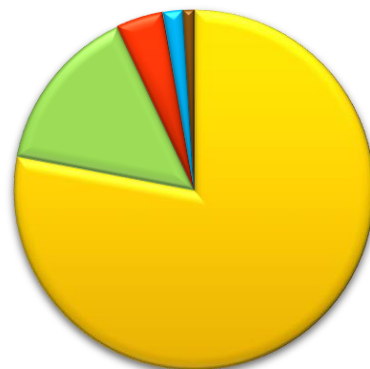

### Feedback About the Infrastructure

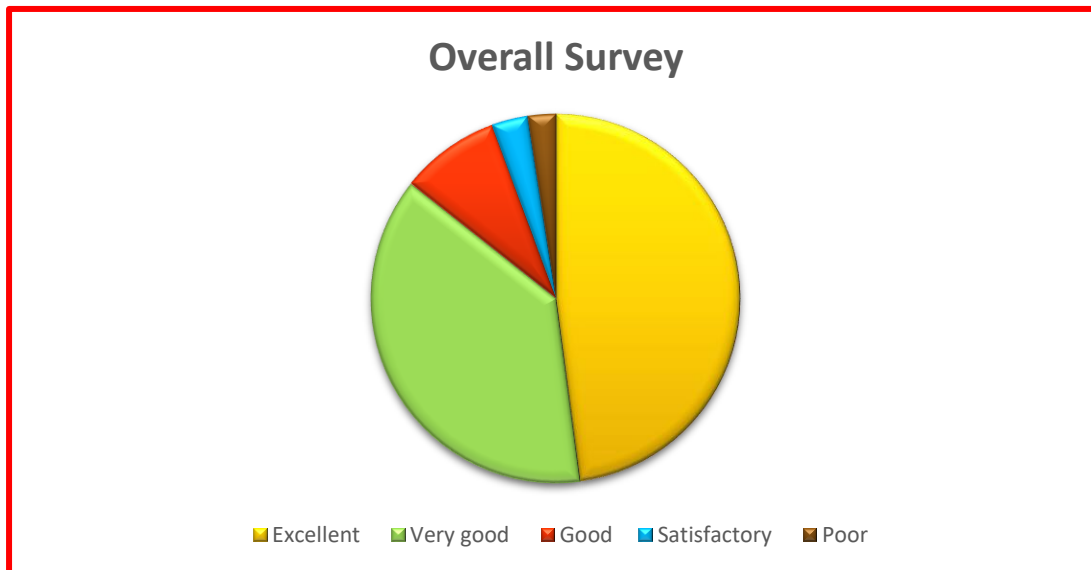

**It can be seen from the graph**

- 44.8% of the students are rating the curriculum as Excellent whereas 46.4% of the students are rating as Very Good
- 46.4% of the students are rating the teaching learning process as Excellent whereas 41.2% of the students are rating as Very Good
- 52% of the laboratory course students are rating the Laboratory interaction as Excellent whereas 42.5% of the students are rating as Very Good
- 43.2% of the students are rating their satisfaction survey on teaching learning process as Excellent as well as very good
- 56.4% of the students are rating the performance of their teachers as Excellent whereas 33.6% of the students are rating as very good
- 34.7% of the students are rating the infrastructure of the college as Excellent whereas 30.8% of the students are rating as very good
- 78% of the students are rating the time sense as Excellent whereas 15% of the students are rating as very good
